



Rules and Regulations

"AWS Community Day Poland"

I. Definitions

Rules and Regulations – these rules and regulations describing the principles of the organization and registration of the Event, as well as the course of the Event with the participation of Attendees, Speakers, and the Organizer, which are available on the website <https://awscommunity.pl/>

Event – the in-person event "AWS Community Day Poland", which will take place on September 8, 2026 at 9:00 AM at Multikino, Złote Tarasy, ul. Złota 59, 00-120 Warsaw.

Registration (also: service, platform) – the online service available at www.evenea.pl supporting the registration process of Attendees for the Event – the privacy policy of the Evenea platform is available on the Evenea website: <https://evenea.pl/pl/polityka-prywatnosci>.

Users – natural and legal persons who meet the conditions of the Rules and Regulations and have accepted them. Users include the Event Organizer, Speakers, and Attendees.

Attendees – Users who participate in the Event.

Organizer – AWS Community Day Poland, represented by: Atanet Gabriela Staszewska, ul. Renifera Rudolfa 14, 05-506 Lesznowola, Tax ID (NIP): 657 15 14 379, which organizes and manages registration for the Event.

Speakers – persons performing and presenting audio-visual content during the Event, which is protected under copyright law within the meaning of the Act of February 4, 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights.

Work – a presentation prepared by a Speaker or a team of Speakers during the Event. The Work is the intellectual property of the Speaker(s) and may include multimedia materials such as slides, audio files, video, graphics, or other visual resources used for the purpose of conveying information, presenting research, discussing topics, or sharing knowledge with Attendees. The Speaker(s) are responsible for the content, quality, and compliance of their Work with the conference themes and any copyrights or licenses related to the materials used.

GDPR – Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

II. Event Registration Rules

1. Registration for the Event is carried out electronically by the Attendee completing the registration form available on the website:

2. Registration and participation in the Event are free of charge for Attendees.
3. Attendees consent to the processing of personal data by the Organizer for marketing purposes.
4. Attendees have the right to withdraw marketing consents.
5. Registration of Attendees for the Event will be conducted electronically from [...] until August 31, 2026.
6. The Organizer reserves the right to close Attendee registration before the deadline specified in point 5.
7. Confirmation of Event registration for the Attendee is sent by e-mail to the e-mail address provided by the Attendee during registration.
8. In the event of not receiving a registration confirmation within three days from the date of Event registration, the Attendee should contact the Organizer by sending a request to the Organizer's e-mail address: hello@awscommunity.pl
9. The Organizer reserves the right to reject an Attendee's registration without providing a reason.
10. The Attendee may withdraw from participation in the Event at any time before it begins by sending an e-mail (indicating the Event name in the subject line) to the Organizer at: hello@awscommunity.pl, or by not attending the Event.
11. The Organizer reserves the right to make available through Registration a greater number of tickets for the Event than the number of seats available at the venue.
12. Attendees will be admitted to the Event venue in order of arrival at the ticket check point until all available seats are filled.
13. On the day of the Event, the Attendee may enter the Event venue until the end of the Event.

III. Participation in the Event

1. The Attendee has the right to participate free of charge in all parts of the Event.

2. Attendees are required to submit to ticket verification at the ticket check point authorizing entry to the Event.
3. During the Event, organizing collections, associations, demonstrations, and other forms of collective action by Event Attendees is prohibited, in particular if such actions are negative or hostile toward other persons.
4. During the Event, Speakers have the right and obligation to present their own works and original content that do not infringe the rights of third parties.
5. During the Event, the Organizer reserves the right to display sponsor logos and other offers and information about sponsors.
6. All proprietary copyrights in respect of Works, documents, and other content presented at the Event belong to the Organizer.
7. Attendees are prohibited from recording, reproducing, and presenting to third parties the content delivered at the Event.
8. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel the Event, change its date, and change Speakers without providing a reason.
9. During the Event, Attendees are required to comply with the provisions of these Rules and Regulations.
10. Failure to comply with the Rules and Regulations by an Attendee may result in their exclusion from participation in the Event by the Organizer, also at the request of a Speaker or other Attendees, without providing a reason.

IV. Attendee Liability

1. Bringing items that may pose a security threat onto the Event premises is strictly prohibited.
2. In particular, the following items are prohibited on the Event premises: all pyrotechnic materials, firearms, rods, batons, sticks, knives, gas canisters, paper rolls, laser flashlights or other laser devices, noisy horns (so-called vuvuzelas), empty and full bottles, smoke flares, brass knuckles, balaclavas, materials of a racist, propagandist, political nature, etc.
3. The Attendee may not bring their own alcohol or substances prohibited by Polish law onto the Event premises.
4. Bringing animals onto the Event premises is strictly prohibited.
5. The Attendee bears full responsibility for their actions on the Event premises.
6. The Attendee shall move only within the parts of the facility designated for the Event and shall not disrupt the course of the Event.
7. The Attendee bears full responsibility for any damage to property at the facility where the Event takes place.
8. The Attendee shall comply with the instructions of the Organizer and the building administrator.
9. The Attendee shall take care of their own safety and the safety of other Event Attendees.

10. If the Attendee requires medical assistance, they shall immediately notify the Organizer or the building administrator.
11. If the Attendee notices that another Attendee needs help, they shall report such need to the Organizer or the building administrator.

V. Personal Data Protection

1. The controller of personal data is the Event Organizer, i.e. AWS Community Day Poland, represented by: Atanet Gabriela Staszewska, ul. Renifera Rudolfa 14, 05-506 Lesznowola, Tax ID (NIP): 657 15 14 379.
2. Each Attendee is required to read these Rules and Regulations.
3. Providing personal data to the Organizer by Attendees is fully voluntary and constitutes the sole independent decision of the Attendees. However, refusal to provide personal data may prevent the Organizer from providing the service as specified in the Rules and Regulations. Where the processing of personal data is based on the Attendee's consent to the processing of personal data (Article 6(1)(a) GDPR), such consent may be withdrawn at any time by contacting the Organizer. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
4. The Organizer may process Attendees' personal data provided during registration for the following legally permitted purposes:
 - Registration and management of the Attendee's account for the duration of that account until its deletion at the Attendee's request, pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) GDPR;
 - Enabling contact via e-mail between the Organizer and the Attendee – pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) GDPR – until withdrawal of the given consent;
 - Establishment, pursuit, or defense of claims that the Organizer or the Attendee may have against each other (this includes data contained in the User's account, for the statute of limitations periods specified in applicable laws);
 - Displaying personalized offers and advertisements during the Event pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – until an objection is lodged.
5. The Organizer ensures appropriate security of personal data, including protection against unauthorized or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, through appropriate technical or organizational measures ("integrity and confidentiality").
6. The Attendee may also give voluntary, specific, informed, and unambiguous consent to the processing of their personal data for other marketing purposes of the Organizer and Speakers, in particular to inform the Attendee about future events organized by the Organizer on topics similar to the Event.
7. The Attendee has the right, at any time and free of charge, to:

- Access their data;
 - Rectification of data;
 - Request cessation of data processing and deletion of their data, which requests should be submitted to the Organizer;
 - Restriction of data processing;
 - Deletion of their data;
 - Portability of their data;
 - Lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority for personal data protection.
8. The Organizer may refuse to delete data if such data is necessary for the Organizer to comply with a legal obligation requiring the processing of that data under European Union or Polish law.
 9. The recipients of Attendees' personal data will be: the Registration platform, Speakers, and authorized entities providing hosting services, website presentation, and other services on behalf of the Organizer, to the extent necessary to achieve the purposes specified in these Rules and Regulations.
 10. Attendees' personal data may also be disclosed to entities authorized to receive them under applicable law, including competent judicial authorities. The Organizer also transfers personal data upon justified request to state administration bodies, law enforcement agencies, and judicial authorities at their express request and only in cases specified by law.
 11. The Organizer has the right to transfer the Attendee's basic data (first and last name) if required by the administration of the building where the Event takes place.
 12. The Event Organizer reserves the right to record audio and video during the Event (as well as results and/or statistics). Pursuant to Article 81(2)(2) of the Act of February 4, 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights, permission is not required for the dissemination of a person's image if that person is merely a detail of a larger whole such as a gathering, landscape, or mass event.

VI. Amendments to the Rules and Regulations
